1. Who did Cornelius fear with all his household?

5. What was it for a man who is a Jew to associate with a foreigner or to visit him?
Unlawful.
6. What did Peter most certainly understand now about God?
He most certainly understands now that God is not one to show partiality, but in every nation the man who fears Him and does what is right is welcome to Him.
7. The word, preaching peace through Jesus Christ, was being sent to whom?
To the sons of Israel.
8. With whom and with what was Jesus of Nazareth anointed by God?
With the Holy Spirit and with power.
9. What had all the prophets witnessed of the Messiah (the Anointed in Hebrew)?
“Of Him all the prophets bear witness that through His name everyone who believes in Him receives forgiveness of sins.”
10. How did all the circumcise believers who came with Peter know that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles (non-Jews) also?
They were hearing the Gentiles (non-Jews) speaking in other languages and exalting God.
