- 6. What was James his judgment to write to the Gentiles?

 That they abstain from things contaminated by idols and from fornication and from what is strangled and from blood.
- 7. Who were being sent to Syrian Antioch with Paul and Barnabas?

 Judas called Barsabbas, and Silas, leading men among the brethren.
- 8. How did the congregation in Syrian Antioch react when they read the letter? They rejoiced because of its encouragement.
- After the sharp disagreement with Paul, who took Barnabas with him and where did
 he go?
 Barnabas took Mark with him and he sailed away to Cyprus.
- 10. And who did Paul chose and what did he do traveling through Syria and Cilicia? Paul chose Silas and he was traveling through Syria and Cilicia, strengthening the churches.
