- 4. What vision appeared to Paul in the night when he was at Alexandria Troas?

 A man of Macedonia was standing and appealing to him, and saying, "Come over to Macedonia and help us."
- 5. What was the city of Philippi of the district of Macedonia and what colony was it? It was a leading city of the district of Macedonia and was a *Roman* colony.
- 6. How could Lydia respond to the things spoken by Paul? The Lord opened Lydia her heart.
- 7. What did the slave-girl, having a spirit of divination, say about Paul, Silas, Timothy and Luke?
 - "These men are bond-servants of the Most High God, who are proclaiming to you the way of salvation."
- 8. At about midnight what were Paul and Silas and the prisoners doing? Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God, and the prisoners were listening to them.
- What did they say to the jailor in order to be saved?
 They said, "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved, you and your household."
- 10. What were the chief magistrates when they heard that Paul and Silas were Romans, and what did they do?
 - They were afraid, and they came and appealed to them, and when they had brought them out, they kept begging them to leave the city of Philippi.
