

## ANSWERS ON THE QUESTIONS OF ACTS CHAPTER 17

1. What did Paul say to the colony of Jews in Thessalonica?  
"This Jesus whom I am proclaiming to you is the Christ."
2. Why did the large disorderly crowd shout Paul when they *began* dragging Jason and some brethren before the city authorities?  
"These men who have upset the world have come here also; and Jason has welcomed them, and they all act contrary to the decrees of Caesar, saying that there is another king, Jesus."
3. How did the Jews of Berea received the word of God?  
With great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see whether these things were so.
4. What happened to Paul's spirit while he was waiting for Silas and Timothy at Athens?  
His spirit was being provoked within him as he was observing the city full of idols.
5. Where and with whom was he reasoning at Athens?  
In the synagogue with the Jews and the God-fearing *Gentiles*, and in the market place every day with those who happened to be present.
6. How did the men of Athens call Paul before they took him and brought him to the Areopagus?  
An idle babbling and a proclaimer of strange deities.
7. How did they worship according to Paul?  
In ignorance.
8. Why is the God who made the world and all things in it not far from each one of us?  
For in Him we live and move and exist.
9. How did God proof to all men that Christ will judge the world in righteousness?  
By raising Him from the dead.
10. What was their reaction when they heard of the resurrection of the dead?  
Some *began* to sneer, others said, "We shall hear you again concerning this."
