1. Why had Aquila recently come from Italy with his wife Priscilla?
Because Claudius had commanded all the Jews to leave Rome.
2. Why did Paul stay with them in Corinth?
Because he was of the same trade. They were also tent-makers.
3. When did Paul leave the Jews and went to the house of a man named Titius Justus, a worshiper of God, whose house was next to the synagogue?
When the Jews resisted his testimony that Jesus was the Christ and blasphemed.
4. When did many of the Corinthians believe and were baptized?
When they heard that Crispus, the leader of the synagogue, believed in the Lord with all his household.
5. What did the Jews say when they brought Paul before the judgment seat?
"This man persuades men to worship God contrary to the law."
6. What was the reaction of Gallio, the proconsul of Achaia?
He was unwilling to be a judge of the questions about words and names of their law.
7. What couple travelled with Paul from Corinth to Ephesus?
Aquila and Priscilla.
8. What did Paul say to the Jews in the synagogue of Ephesus?
"I will return to you again if God wills."
9. What did Priscilla and Aquila do when they heard Apollo speaking?
They took him aside and explained to him the way of God more accurately.
10. How did Apollo help those who had believed through grace in Achaia?
By powerfully refuting the Jews in public, demonstrating by the Scriptures that Jesus was the Christ.
