1. What did Paul give the brethren in the districts of Macedonia?
Much exhortation.
2. Why did Paul decided to return to Macedonia after spending three months in Greece?
A plot was formed against him by the Jews as he was about to set sail for Syria.
3. By whom was he accompanied??
He was accompanied by Sopater of Berea, the son of Pyrrhus, and by Aristarchus and Secundus of the Thessalonians, and Gaius of Derbe, and Timothy, and Tychicus and Trophimus of Asia.
4. What were there in the upper room where the Christian believers gathered together in Troas?
Many lamps.
5. Why did a young man named Eutychus sitting on the window sill, fell down?
He sank into a deep sleep; and as Paul kept on talking, he was overcome by sleep.
6. How did Paul restore Eutychus to life?
Paul went down and fell upon him, and after embracing him, he said, "Do not be troubled, for his life is in him."
7. Why had Paul decided to sail past Ephesus?
So that he would not have to spend time in Asia; for he was hurrying to be in Jerusalem, if possible, on the day of Pentecost.
8. From what place did he sent to Ephesus and called to him the elders of the church?
Miletus.
9. What ministry had Paul received from the Lord Jesus?
To testify solemnly of the gospel of the grace of God.
10. What had the apostle Paul shown the elders of the church in Ephesus to do?
That by working hard you must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He Himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'
