

ANSWERS ON THE QUESTIONS OF ACTS CHAPTER 21

1. In what city did Paul and his travel companions find a ship crossing over to Phoenicia?
Patara.
2. How long did they stay at Tyre in Syria, where the ship was to unload its cargo?
Seven days.
3. Where did Paul meet a prophet named Agabus who came down from Judea?
At Caesarea in the house of Philip the evangelist, who was one of the seven.
4. Since Paul would not be persuaded not to go up to Jerusalem, what did Paul's travel companions do?
They fell silent, remarking, "The will of the Lord be done!"
5. Once in Jerusalem, what did Paul do after greeting James and all the elders?
He began to relate one by one the things which God had done among the Gentiles through his ministry.
6. What did James and the elders tell Paul that he should do?
They told him that they have four men who are under a vow. He should take them and purify himself along with them, and pay their expenses so that they may shave their heads; and all will know that there is nothing to the things which they have been told about Paul, but that he himself also walks orderly, keeping the Law.
7. Who began to stir up all the crowd and laid hands on him?
The Jews from Asia.
8. Who did they suppose that Paul had brought into the temple?
Trophimus the Ephesian.
9. What did the commander of the Roman cohort do after taking hold of Paul?
He ordered him to be bound with two chains; and he began asking who he was and what he had done.
10. In what language did Paul speak to the commander?
In Greek.
