1. In what dialect was Paul addressing the Jews?
In the Hebrew dialect.
2. Paul had been educated under whom?
Gamaliel, the most honored rabbi of the first century.
3. How did Paul persecute the Way (followers of Jesus Christ His earthly teachings)?
He persecuted this Way to the death, binding and putting both men and women into prisons.
4. Who spoke to Paul from heaven on his way to Damascus?
Jesus the Nazarene, whom Paul was persecuting.
5. According to Ananias, God had appointed Paul for what?
God had appointed Paul to know His will and to see the Righteous One and to hear an utterance from His mouth.
6. What did the risen Jesus Christ say to Paul while he was praying in the temple?
'Make haste, and get out of Jerusalem quickly, because they will not accept your testimony about Me.'
7. Up to what statement did the Jews listen to Paul?
After Paul said to them that God told him, 'Go! For I will send you far away to the Gentiles.'
8. What did Paul say to the centurion who was standing by when they stretched him out with thongs?
"Is it lawful for you to scourge a man who is a Roman and uncondemned?"
9. What's the difference between the Roman citizenship of the commander and the one of Paul?
The commander acquired his Roman citizenship with a large sum of money and Paul was actually born a Roman citizen."
10. What did the commander do to know for certain why Paul had been accused by the Jews?
He released him and ordered the chief priests and all the Council to assemble, and brought Paul down and set him before them.
