

ANSWERS ON THE QUESTIONS OF ACTS CHAPTER 24

1. After how many days came the high priest Ananias down with some elders and an attorney named Tertullus?
After five days.
2. What was the first charge against Paul?
That he was a public menace and one who stirs up dissensions among all the Jews throughout the world.
3. What was the second charge against Paul?
That he was a ringleader of the sect of the Nazarenes.
4. What was the third charge against Paul?
He even tried to desecrate the temple.
5. How did Paul deal with the charge of sedition?
That no more than twelve days ago he went up to Jerusalem to worship. And that neither in the temple did they find him carrying on a discussion with anyone or causing a riot, nor in the synagogues, nor in the city itself.
6. How did the apostle Paul answer the charge of heresy?
That he did serve the God of their fathers, believing everything that is in accordance with the Law and is written in the Prophets.
7. How did the apostle Paul answer the charge of sacrilege?
That after several years he came to bring charitable gifts to his nation and to present offerings, in which they found him occupied in the temple, having been purified, without any crowd or uproar.
8. What did Felix do after he arrived some days later with Drusilla his wife, who was Jewish?
He sent for Paul and heard him speak about faith in Christ Jesus.
9. What did Paul discuss during the interview with Felix and Drusilla?
Righteousness, self-control, and the judgment to come.
10. Why used Felix to send for Paul quite often and talk to him?
Besides communing with him, Felix was also hoping that money would be given to him by Paul.
