- v. 1 What was every truly saved believer in Christ before believing the gospel of the grace of God? *Dead in his/her trespasses and sins*
- v. 2 How did every truly saved believer in Christ walk before believing the gospel of the grace of God? According to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience
- v. 2 Who is the prince of the power of the air (see also Acts 26:18)? Satan
- v. 3 How had all truly saved believers in Christ their conversation in times past? In the lusts of their flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh and of the mind
- v. 3 What type of children were truly saved believers in Christ before believing the gospel of the grace of God? They were by nature the children of wrath, even as others
- v. 4 Why did God show us mercy? For his great love wherewith he loved us
- v. 5 What did God do for truly saved believers in Christ even though they were dead in sins? He hath quickened them together with Christ, (by grace they are saved)
- v. 6 What is the position now for truly saved believers in Christ? God hath raised them up together with Christ, and made them sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus
- v. 7 What might God show in the ages to come? God might show the exceeding riches of his grace, in his kindness toward truly saved believers in Christ Jesus
- v. 8 Salvation from hell and the future lake of fire is a gift of God by what and through what? By grace and through faith

- v. 19 What are Gentiles no longer? Strangers and foreigners
- v. 19 What are Gentiles now? They are fellow citizens with the saints and of the household of God
