- v. 1 What was every truly saved believer in Christ before believing the gospel of the grace of God? *Dead in his/her trespasses and sins*
- v. 2 How did every truly saved believer in Christ walk before believing the gospel of the grace of God? *According to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, of the spirit that is now working in the sons of disobedience*
- v. 2 Who is the prince of the power of the air (see also Acts 26:18)? *Satan*
- v. 3 How lived all truly saved believers in Christ formerly? *In the lusts of their flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind*
- v. 3 What type of children were truly saved believers in Christ before believing the gospel of the grace of God? *They were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest*
- v. 4 Why did God show us mercy? *Because of His great love with which He loved us*
- v. 5 What did God do for truly saved believers in Christ even though they were dead in their transgressions? *He made them alive together with Christ (by grace they have been saved)*
- v. 6 What is the position now for truly saved believers in Christ? *God raised them up with Christ, and seated them with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus*
- v. 7 What might God show in the ages to come? *God might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward truly saved believers in Christ Jesus*
- v. 8 Salvation from hell and the future lake of fire is a gift of God by what and through what? *By grace and through faith*
- v. 9 Why is salvation from hell and the future lake of fire not a result of works? *So that no one may boast*
- v. 10 For what purpose were truly saved believers in Christ created? *For good works, which God prepared beforehand so that they would walk in them*
- v. 11 How were Gentiles in the flesh formerly being called by the so-called "Circumcision," which is performed in the flesh by human hands? *"Uncircumcision"*
- v. 12 What were Gentiles in the flesh formerly? *Separated from Christ, excluded from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers to the covenants of promise, having no hope and without God in the world*
- v. 13 How have the "far off" Gentiles been brought near? *By the blood of Christ*
- v. 14 How did Christ make peace between Jews and Gentiles? *He made both groups into one and broke down the barrier of the dividing wall*
- v. 15 What did Christ abolish in His flesh? *The enmity, which is the Law of commandments contained in ordinances*
- v. 16 By what means did God make "one body" out of truly saved Jew and Gentile believers in Christ? *The cross*
- v. 17 Who were those who were far off from God? *Gentiles*
- v. 17 Who were those who were near to God? *Jews*
- v. 18 What access do Jews and Gentiles have now? *Access in one Spirit to the Father through Christ*
- v. 19 What are Gentiles no longer? *Strangers and aliens*
- v. 19 What are Gentiles now? *They are fellow citizens with the saints, and of God's household*
- v. 20 Who is the corner stone? *Christ Jesus Himself*
- v. 21 How does Paul call the whole living building of God? *A holy temple in the Lord*
- v. 22 Through whom is God dwelling in the Body of Christ part of God's living building? *The Spirit*
- v. 22 This verse, like verse 18, refers to all three members of what? *The Trinity*
