- v. 1 Whose prisoner did Paul say he was? The prisoner of Jesus Christ
- v. 1 For whose benefit was Paul a prisoner? For the Gentiles
- v. 2 What is our present dispensation called? The dispensation of the grace of God
- v. 3 How was the mystery of the Body of Christ made known to Paul? By revelation (God's disclosure of Himself and of His will to His creatures)
- v. 4 In whose writings you will gain information about the mystery (truths about the Body of Christ)? *In Paul's letters to the Body of Christ*
- v. 5 Concerning the mystery of Christ, what does Paul say about other ages? It was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit
- v. 6 What was the message of this mystery? That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body, and partakers of God's promise in Christ by the gospel
- v. 7 How did Paul become a minister of the mystery? According to the gift of the grace of God
- v. 7 How was the minister gift of the "mystery message" given unto Paul? By the effectual working of God's power
- v. 8 What did Paul call himself? Less than the least of all saints
- v. 8 What did Paul preach to the Gentiles? The unsearchable riches of Christ
- v. 9 How long had the mystery been kept? From the beginning of the world it has been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ
- v. 10 How might now the manifold wisdom of God be known? By the church (Body of Christ) unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places
- v. 11 The bringing to light of the administration of the mystery agrees with what? *It's according to the eternal purpose which God purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord*
- v. 12 What do we have by the faith of Jesus Christ? Boldness and access with confidence
- v. 13 Paul desired the saints at Ephesus not to faint at what? At his tribulations on their behalf, which is their glory
- v. 14 What does Paul start to do in this verse until the end of chapter 3? He expresses a prayer
- v. 16 Truly saved believers in Christ can be strengthened with what? With might by God's Spirit in the inner man
- v. 17 Christ may dwell where? In the hearts of truly saved believers in Christ
