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- v. 1 Whose prisoner did Paul say he was? The prisoner of Christ Jesus
- v. 1 For whose benefit was Paul a prisoner? For the sake of Gentiles
- v. 2 What is our present dispensation called? The stewardship of God's grace
- v. 3 How was the mystery of the Body of Christ made known to Paul? By revelation (God's disclosure of Himself and of His will to His creatures)
- v. 4 In whose writings you will gain information about the mystery (truths about the Body of Christ)? *In Paul's letters to the Body of Christ*
- v. 5 Concerning the mystery of Christ, what does Paul say about other generations? It was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit
- v. 6 What was the message of this mystery? That the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel
- v. 7 How did Paul become a minister of the mystery? According to the gift of God's grace
- v. 7 How was the minister gift of the "mystery message" given to Paul? According to the working of God's power
- v. 8 What did Paul call himself? The very least of all saints
- v. 8 What did Paul preach to the Gentiles? The unfathomable riches of Christ
- v. 9 How long had the mystery been kept? For ages it has been hidden in God who created all things
- v. 10 How might now the manifold wisdom of God be made known? Through the church (Body of Christ) to the rulers and the authorities in the heavenly places
- v. 11 The bringing to light of the administration of the mystery agrees with what? It's in accordance with the eternal purpose which God carried out in Christ Jesus our Lord
- v. 12 What do we have through faith in Jesus Christ? Boldness and confident access
- v. 13 Paul asked the saints at Ephesus not to be distressed at what? At his tribulations on their behalf, for they are their glory
- v. 14 What does Paul start to do in this verse until the end of chapter 3? He expresses a prayer
- v. 16 Truly saved believers in Christ can be strengthened with what? With power through God's Spirit in the inner man
- v. 17 Christ may dwell where? In the hearts of truly saved believers in Christ
- v. 17 How may Christ dwell in the hearts of truly saved believers in Christ? Through faith
- v. 17 What will be the result of Christ dwelling in the hearts of truly saved believers in Christ through faith? *They will be rooted and grounded in love*
- v. 18-19 What may a truly saved believer in Christ comprehend with all the saints? What is the breadth and length and height and depth of the love of Christ
- v. 19 What surpasses knowledge? The love of Christ
- v. 19 Once you know the love of Christ, a truly saved believer in Christ may be filled up to what? To all the fullness of God
- v. 20 What is God able to do for a truly saved believer in Christ? Far more abundantly beyond all that he/she asks or thinks
- v. 20 According to what is God able to do far more abundantly beyond all that a truly saved believer in Christ asks or thinks? *According to the power that works within him/her*
- v. 21 To Whom be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever? *To God*
